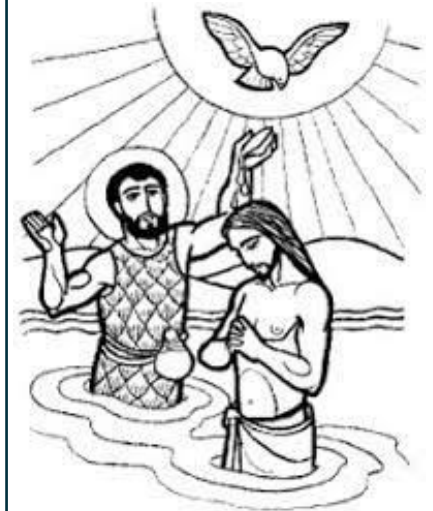

REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY

The Solemnity of the Baptism of the Lord invites us to reflect on the humility and love of Jesus. Though sinless, Jesus chose to be baptized by John in the Jordan River, not for purification, but to identify with humanity and sanctify the waters for our rebirth. This act reveals His solidarity with us and marks the beginning of His public ministry.

When Jesus is baptized, the heavens open, the Holy Spirit descends like a dove, and the Father's voice proclaims, "You are my beloved Son." This moment reveals the intimate relationship of the Trinity and calls us to embrace our own identity as beloved children of God, made sharers in the divine life through our baptism.

As we celebrate this feast, we are reminded of our own baptismal call to live as Christ lived—loving, serving, and sharing God's light with the world. May this solemnity renew our commitment to live out our baptismal grace and share God's love with all.
