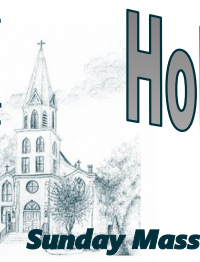

REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY

Today's Sunday calls us to reflect on the coming of the Lord and the importance of staying prepared. In the Gospel, Jesus speaks of the end times, using vivid imagery of the sun darkening and stars falling from the sky. These signs remind us that our earthly lives are temporary and that God's kingdom is eternal. Christ's message is not to instill fear but to inspire hope and vigilance. He assures us that His words will never pass away, emphasizing the reliability of God's promises. This Sunday invites us to live with an awareness of our final destiny. It encourages us to align our lives with God's will, focusing on love, justice, and mercy. The readings challenge us to let go of worldly distractions and place our trust in Christ. As disciples, we are called to persevere in faith, even in challenging times. The anticipation of Christ's return motivates us to grow in holiness and be ready to meet Him. Ultimately, the liturgy reassures us that God is in control, guiding history toward its fulfillment in Him.
