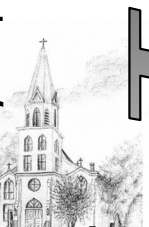

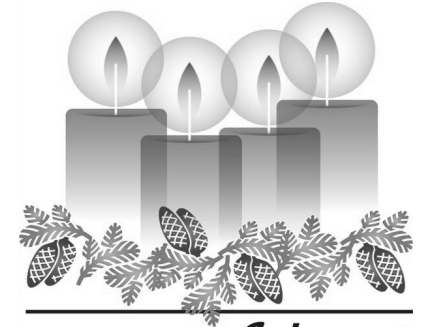

REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY

On this Fourth Sunday of Advent, the readings invite us to reflect on the peace that comes through trust in God's promises. In the first reading, the prophet Micah speaks of a ruler who will bring peace, a promise fulfilled in the birth of Jesus. This peace is not simply an external absence of conflict, but an inner peace rooted in God's faithfulness. In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us that God calls us to live in peace with one another, trusting that He will guide and strengthen us. In the Gospel, Mary's visit to Elizabeth exemplifies the joy and peace that come from trusting in God's plan. Her words, "Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled," call us to place our trust in God's promises, knowing He will bring peace to our hearts. As we await the coming of Christ, may we live in His peace and work to be instruments of peace in the world.
