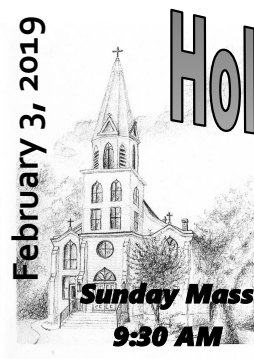


- United Women Society will meet always on First Sunday of each month after Mass.
