# **REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY**

Today's Gospel tells us about Mary Magdalene going to Jesus' tomb early one morning. She finds the stone moved and tells Peter and another disciple. They run to the tomb, and the other disciple gets there first but waits outside. Peter goes in and sees the burial cloths but no body. Then the other disciple goes in, and he believes that Jesus has risen from the dead. Even though they didn't understand it at the time, this moment is important because it shows their faith in Jesus. It's like a reminder for us to trust even when things seem confusing or uncertain. Mary's devotion, Peter's courage, and the other disciple's belief teach us about love, bravery, and faith.
