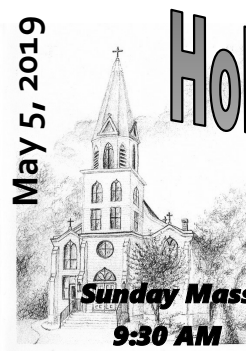

DIOCESAN EVENTS

- The 68th Annual Convention of the United Women’s Societies for the Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament in the Eastern Diocese will be held on Saturday, May 18, 2019 Our Saviour’s Parish in Woonsocket, RI. Mass will begin at 10 AM.
- Our 2019 Eastern Diocese Acolyte Retreat will be held on Tuesday - June 25, 2019 at Our Saviour’s Parish in Woonsocket, RI. The theme is „Discipleship:2019 - Following Jesus”. The retreat will begin with Holy Mass at 9:30 AM followed by sessions on Discipleship, Serving in Processions and Serving at Para-Liturgical services.
