Dear Brothers and Sisters

During our Mass we have to follow guidelines from the State of Massachusetts and from our Prime Bishops.

- Everyone must wear a face mask.
- Everyone must keep social distancing – at least 6 feet - except members of the same household.
- There will be a designated person to direct you to a pew, so please sit where they will tell you to sit.
- There is no choir or congregational singing.
- There will be no Holy Communion distributed to the people. An Act of the Spiritual Communion will be read at the end of the Mass, so we can receive Jesus Christ spiritually into our hearts.
- There will be no shaking hands, greetings before and after the Mass.
- The Holy Water will be removed from the font.
- Parish bulletin and readings will be placed in the pews prior to the Mass. Please take them home after Mass. Nothing can stay in the pew.
- Sunday collections should be placed in the basket on the table at the main door.
- Hand sanitizer will be available on the table in the back of the church.
- Please keep social distancing while leaving church after Mass.
- There will be no Coffee Hour, no gatherings in the church hall after the Mass.
