

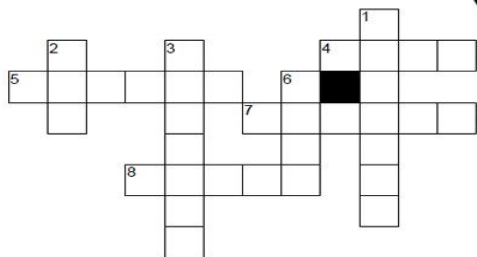

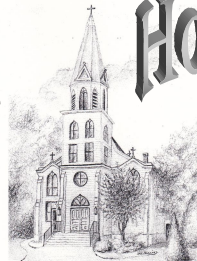

### A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Luke (10:1-9)
