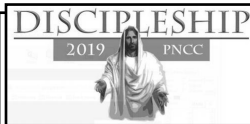

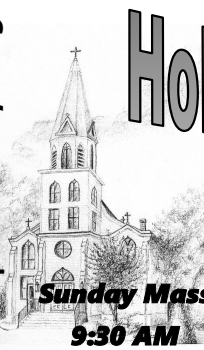

### **DIOCESAN and CHURCH EVENTS**

- **On Sunday, September 8, 2019 St. Joseph's Parish in Westfield, MA will hold its annual Dozynki - Polish Harvest Festival** from 12 Noon until 4 PM.
- **2019 Special Synod of the Polish National Catholic Church** will take place on Friday, October 25, 2019 at St. Stanislaus Youth Center in Scranton, PA. At its regular meeting on May 1, 2019, the Supreme Council determined that two (2) candidates for bishop will be elected by the Special Synod. As the Constitution states the election of candidates for bishop will be the sole purpose of this one-day Synod. The Parishes are reminded to elect delegates in the same manner as they would for a General Synod.
