## REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY

In today's Gospel, Jesus points to the poor widow who gives all she has—two small coins—to the temple treasury. Jesus praises her not for the size of her gift, but for the depth of her trust in God. While the rich give from their abundance, the widow gives from her poverty, showing true generosity and faith.

This story challenges us to reflect on how we give. It's not about how much we offer, but the spirit in which we give. Are we willing to offer God what we have, no matter how little, trusting that He will provide for us? The widow reminds us that true giving comes from a heart of love and trust, not from seeking recognition or rewards.

May we follow her example, giving generously of our time, talents, and resources, with a heart fully surrendered to God.
