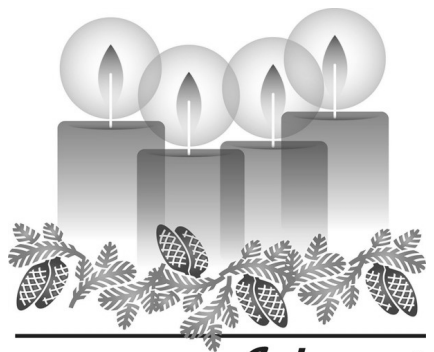

**Reflection for Sunday**
